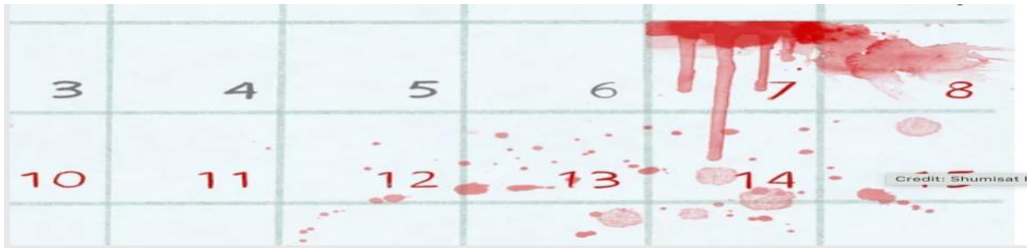


Special Report 115, Israel Under Attack



Mohammad Raze Zahadi was Iran's foremost commander in Syria, in charge of weapons supply, strategic planning and **coordination between Iran's El Quds forces, Hezbollah, Hamas, Islamic Jihad and Syria** in an under the radar war with Israel. He was engaged with the afore-mentioned terrorist organizations in planning a major attack against Israel. The unmarked building attacked while he and other senior terrorist leaders were meeting was purposely situated between the Iranian and the Canadian Embassies. Immediately following the attack attributed to Israel, Iran put up a sign stating the building was a consulate. Iran accused Israel for the attack and threatened revenge. While the majority of interceptions were the product of Israel's advanced, multi-layered defensive system, the battleships US moved into the area, and these played a significant role in discovering and intercepting Iran's projectiles.
