



## **The Morning After Devotional**

### Galatians 5:1

Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

This letter to the Galatians is centered on, or at least consistent with, Godly freedom predicated upon justification. To be justified is to be counted as righteous, knowing that one is not righteous. Nonetheless, it is in this letter that Paul wrote to believers, who faced the onslaught of the Judaizers attempting to pull them back under the bondage of the law. Life has a way of putting us in the same position. No, we are not troubled by the Judaizers, but what about the racism, injustices, judgements by the unjust, and even our own sinful desires, decrees, and distractions? Moreover, we are under constant attack by our enemy, the deceiver.

Nonetheless, the apostle gave the Galatians advice that transcends trials, and time, hence it is sufficient for us as well. First, the apostle said, **Consider your Position**, "Stand fast therefore". Paul warned the Galatians not to give in to the pressures of the Judaizers, likewise brothers and sisters let us not give in to our pressures. Further Paul said, **Remember His Passion**, "in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free." We must in times of trials remember the passion of our Christ, and his suffering as our Savior. Finally, Paul exhorted the church to, **Maintain in the Present**, "and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage." Paul's exhortation appeared to be indicative of continuing and/or future onslaughts. Given that, the apostle concluded firmly by calling it as it was an entanglement with bondage. Brothers and sister, until the next time may our God continue to be our guide.

The Prayer: Father, we thank you for keeping us as we are unable to keep ourselves. We offer our prayer in the name of Jesus the Christ. Amen.
