DID YOU KNOW?

1972 Equal Rights Amendment

The Equal Rights Amendment was originally written in 1921 by suffragist Alice Paul and had been introduced to Congress every year since 1923, and finally passed this year. Hawaii became the first of 34 other states to ratify the Equal Rights Amendment and prohibit discrimination on the basis of sex, but the bill hit anti-feminist backlash in the mid-'70s and failed to become ratified by the necessary 38 states by its July 1982 deadline.





May Recipes & Kitchen Tips

Air Fryer Potatoes

Ingredients:

- 24 oz small red potatoes
- 1-2 tbs extra virgin oil
- Salt and pepper for seasoning
- 1-2 tbs minced fresh herbs, such as thyme, chives, rosemary, parsley or oregano
- 1/4 cup freshly grated parmesan cheese



Directions:

- Place halved potatoes in a bowl and toss with olive oil.
- Season with salt and pepper and toss again
- Cook in an air fryer at 380 degrees for 20 minutes, shaking the basket halfway through
- Toss warm potatoes with herbs and Parmesan and serve immediately

Mom's Signature Vanilla Wafer Cake

Ingredients:

- Cream 2 sticks of butter with 2 cups of sugar
- Add dash of vanilla
- Add 6 eggs (1 at a time after beating)
- Add 1 box of crushed Vanilla Wafers to egg mixture
- Add 2 cups of chopped pecans
- Add 2 cups of shredded coconut

Directions:

- Mix well and pour into greased and floured bunt pan.
- Bake at 300° for about 1 hour. It should be light golden brown. Just make sure the center doesn't jiggle. Over cooking it is the worst thing you can do.
- It is a very moist cake that gets better everyday.

Turmeric Rice With Peas

Ingredients:

- 2 Tbs olive oil (or clarified butter)
- 1 clover garlic, peeled
- 1 Cup Basmati rice
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 tsp ground turmeric
- 2 cups water
- 1 cup frozen petite green peas

Directions:

- In a saucepan, with fitting lid, heat oil over medium heat. Add garlic and cook, flipping garlic occasionally to prevent burning, until lightly brown.
- Leaving garlic in the oil, add 1 cup rice and 1 tsp salt. With a wooden spoon, stir the rice in the hot oil until the rice turns a chalky white color.
- Add 2 cups water and 1 tsp turmeric and stir to combine.
 Increase heat to high and bring to a boil. Immediately reduce heat to low, cover with lid, and simmer on low for 15 minutes.
- Remove lid and quickly add frozen peas. Replace lid and cook for 5 minutes more and turn off heat.
- Fluff rice with a fork, remove garlic and serve

Pepper Jack Bacon Jalapeno Scones

Ingredients:

- 2 cup Bob's Red Mill® Organic All-Purpose Flour
- 2 tbsp Freeze Dried Jalapeños
- 2 tbsp Freeze Dried Garlic
- ¼ tsp Salt
- 1 tbsp Baking Powder
- 2 tbsp GloryBee® Artisan Fermented Honey
- ½ cup+ 2 tbsp. Buttermilk or Heavy Cream, plus extra for brushing on top
- 1 ea Egg
- ½ lbs Cooked Maple Bacon, about 4 slices, cut or crumbled into small pieces
- 1 cup Grated Pepper Jack Cheese
- ½ cup Cold Butter, cut into small pieces
- 1 ea Flaky Salt, for topping

Directions:

- Preheat oven to 400°F. Lightly grease a baking sheet, or cover with parchment paper.
- Combine the flour, Freeze Dried Jalapeños, Freeze Dried Garlic, salt and baking powder in a medium bowl. In a separate bowl, whisk together fermented honey, buttermilk or cream and the egg.
- Add the wet ingredient mixture, crumbled bacon, and cheese to the flour mixture. Mix gently with a spoon to moisten the dough.
- Add the cold butter pieces to the flour mixture. Using your hands, an electric mixer or a pastry cutter, work the butter into the flour. The dough should be soft and crumbly, with different sized pieces of butter. If it remains too dry, add more buttermilk or cream, 1 tablespoon at a time, until it comes together into a ball.
- Transfer the dough ball to the prepared baking sheet and press it into a round disk, ¾ of an inch thick.
- Slice the dough into 8 wedges. Separate the wedges slightly on the baking sheet. Brush with cream or buttermilk, and sprinkle each with a pinch of flaky salt.
- Bake for 18-22 minutes, until golden brown. Let cool on the baking sheet and enjoy warm or refrigerate in an airtight container. Reheat to serve!

AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES (A Newsletter Series - Part 3)

Amendment XII.

Passed by Congress December 9, 1803. Ratified June 15, 1804. (Note: A portion of Article II, Section 1 of the Constitution was changed by the 12th Amendment.)

The Electors shall meet in their respective states, and vote by ballot for President and Vice-President, one of whom, at least, shall not be an inhabitant of the same state with themselves; they shall name in their ballots the person voted for as President, and in distinct ballots the person voted for as Vice-President, and they shall make distinct lists of all persons voted for as President, and of all persons voted for as Vice-President, and of the number of votes for each, which lists they shall sign and certify, and transmit sealed to the seat of the government of the United States, directed to the President of the Senate;-the President of the Senate shall, in the presence of the Senate and House of Representatives, open all the certificates and the votes shall then be counted;-The person having the greatest number of votes for President, shall be the President, if such number be a majority of the whole number of Electors appointed; and if no person have such majority, then from the persons having the highest numbers not exceeding three on the list of those voted for as President, the House of Representatives shall choose immediately, by ballot, the President. But in choosing the President, the votes shall be taken by states, the representation from each state having one vote; a quorum for this purpose shall consist of a member or members from twothirds of the states, and a majority of all the states shall be necessary to a choice. [And if the House of Representatives shall not choose a President whenever the right of choice shall devolve upon them, before the fourth day of March next following, then the Vice-President shall act as President, as in case of the death or other constitutional disability of the President.-]* The person having the greatest number of votes as Vice-President, shall be the Vice-President, if such number be a majority of the whole number of Electors appointed, and if no person have a majority, then from the two highest numbers on the list, the Senate shall choose the Vice-President; a quorum for the purpose shall consist of two-thirds of the whole number of Senators, and a majority of the whole number shall be necessary to a choice. But no person constitutionally ineligible to the office of President shall be eligible to that of Vice-President of the United States.

*Superseded by Section 3 of the 20th Amendment.
