



In the third century, the theologian Tertullian noted how the Romans viewed the Christins: "The romans remarked, "Look, how they love one another."

This is the mark of a Christians. Love is the simplest and most difficult of commandments. We are invited to surrender our choosing and understand ourselves as being chosen, chosen to reveal the love of God by caring for those who are opposed to us, loving those who hate us, and erasing every boundary to our love that we have erected. Jesus wants us to share in his love, the love of the Father. The only way to do that is to find the edge of our loving, our compassion our concern and push past it. On the other side of our edges, we will find that God is already there, already loving those we had determined were unlovable. This may be one of the most radical and revelatory ideas in the entire Bible. The concept of loving our enemies undoes all our prejudgments and our tendencies to externalize evil in the unknown other.

St. John Paul II instead calls us to see the other "as part of me." When we do this, we an experience the reality of unity and interconnection that we all share and shatter the illusion of our separateness. We see with God's eyes and begin to love the way God loves. We leave behind our smallness and participate in the largeness that is the truth of our life. This is the invitation that Jesus offers us today. When we do join God on the other side of our boundaries, we will be transformed people. We will become what we are called to be; true witnesses and living examples of the love of God.
