- marriage and civil partnership
- pregnancy and maternity
- race (including color, nationality, and ethnic or national origin)
- religion or belief
- sex
- sexual orientation

Additionally, BPC commits to having an environment free of bullying, harassment, victimization, and unlawful discrimination, promoting dignity and respect for all, and where individual differences and the contributions of all are recognized and valued.

If this policy is violated, the offended party shall report the offense to the Pastor, Clerk of Session or to a member of Session in a timely fashion for appropriate action.
