ABOUT BROKEN BREAD



<u>Broken Bread Ministries, Inc.</u>, inaugurated on July 27, 2021, is a place for people to receive the Word of God, aka the Bread of Life, so that their lives become Christ-like. In turn, they are called by God to be broken, to lay down their wills in submission to God. As they grow in wisdom and experience God, they become broken bread to feed others who are hungry for God.

Broken Bread ministries began when **Pastor Christa Dickey** heard the voice of an angel tell her to start a bible study and to call it "Broken Bread." As Christa describes further, "I then saw a vision of Jesus with robes on but they were open and His chest was bare. I could see inside His chest, and it was filled with pieces of broken bread. And Jesus had this look of anguish as though if I were to take the bread, it would provide a relief. It was as if He was saying, 'Relieve Me by using this bread to feed (my sheep). Eat this bread and in this way, I would be relieved.' I had an understanding that there was a word that He wanted to go out to the people, and He is asking me to enlist in this effort so that He could use me to feed others His word. (Jeremiah 3:15 KJV)"

True to its purpose, Broken Bread Ministries hosts a bible study every week, which is a space for the Holy Spirit to have His way in and around God's people. Faithfully, we "break bread" together by way of prayer, worship, teachings, prophetic words and testimonies, and "recognize" the Lord in this way (<u>Luke 24:35 NASB</u>). PERSONAL PENTECOST

~ Exodus 20:24 KJV

An altar of earth thou shalt make unto me, and shalt sacrifice thereon thy burnt offerings, and thy peace offerings, thy sheep, and thine oxen: in all places where I record my name I will come unto thee, and I will bless thee.

In June 2022, **Pastor William H. Murphy** addressed the congregation of **The dReamCenter Church of Atlanta** where he shared a message given to him by the Lord entitled "BENCHMARKS." He defined benchmarks as "the standards by which you evaluate, and check, and measure your effectiveness." Benchmarks tell you if your life is on course with what God wants; they tell you if you are in God's will." The Ten Commandments are benchmarks given by God through Moses, a prophetic intercessor who could stand between Heaven and earth and tell the people what is God's will. As he continued the sermon, Pastor Murphy pronounced that God is about to trust you with power;" and then emphasized that it is the benchmarks that are going to open the door (to that power), and keep you there.

Pastor Murphy went on to tell us to prepare. "You are about to encounter God's spirit in a way that is going to change your life forever. POWER is about to hit your life." He explained that this power will be accompanied by ELEVATION. "God is about to increase you in stature with man and put you on another level." The Father said, "the shaking and the chaos prior to now was Me preparing you for your own personal Pentecost and the purpose of this Pentecost is to reposition you, to prepare you to function from an elevated place. The way you functioned in the old place will be out of order for this new place."

The Father's word about power and elevation echoed in several messages throughout the year.

- In March, the Lord gave an Epistle word through **Prophet George M. Boykin of Broken Bread Ministries** in which the Lord said the following about the elevation that is to come:
 - "When there is sacrifice accompanied by His Name, when we call upon His Name, when we do these things, (there will be) greater, greater, greater."
 - "These are the times of fishermen of men. The hauls are greater, but the stakes are higher."
 - "There is an urgency now. It is almost like things are coming to an end. He just wants us to stay focused on Him, and to reach for Him. No matter what happens, reach for Him, and He will turn the world around us."
- In July, the Scribe for Broken Bread Ministries was led to a teaching called "Everything Must Go!" by Pastor Sarah Jakes Roberts in which Sarah preached that after Peter denied Christ, "God was not calling him back to being the disciple who followed Jesus, but instead to become the rock on which Jesus built His church." She called this ACCELERATION, which like elevation is "when God takes what was and accelerates it to what He said it was going to be."
- In September, **Pastor Marney L. Wooldridge**, was a guest speaker at Broken Bread Ministries' bible study and released the following word from the Lord.
 - "A season is coming and it is right around the corner (soon) that God wants us to release our old wine, to release our old flesh (bitterness, frustration, offense, bad habits that are sin, bad choices, etc.)."
 - "The Lord is saying "Are you willing?" This is a call to you right now. Are you willing to let that go so you can receive the new wine?"
 - Are you willing to receive what I already poured out in Acts 2 (Acts 2:17 KJV) that I want to manifest now?"

In his sermon, Pastor Murphy continued on to explain that, "Pentecost is all about God giving man His Spirit. He tells His people what to do and gives His Spirit so they can do it." The Father says, "I show you how to live and then I take up residence in you, and live in you, so you can live for Me."

Pastor Murphy closed with God's intention for our personal Pentecosts. "The whole point of Pentecost is to make sure that where you go, God goes." He defied the misconception that Pentecost was a power just to edify the church, and clarified that it is a power to edify culture. He focused on how Pentecost pointed to racism, classism and sexism, and how the presence of the Holy Spirit in the disciples struck a blow against these cultural issues. (Acts 2:1-21 KJV) When those who receive the power that is about to come forth walk in, culture should change, conversations should change. The Father said, 'I'm not trying to make you popular in church. I'm trying to make you powerful in culture so you can get something done." God is not looking for just priests popular in church, but kings who are popular in culture who are not just praying, but are positioned to take the seat of power (for the Kingdom of God).

And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:
