PASTOR'S CORNER

Saying "No" and Saying "Yes"

We are now in the season of Lent, a 40-day period of preparation for Easter. A time in which we say "no" in order to say "yes." We say "no" to the things that prevent us from reflecting on our life in Christ and that take time from being in connection with our God. This saying "no" is what we call fasting, and it isn't necessarily from food. It's from anything (social media, unhealthy levels of alcohol or drugs (remember caffeine is a drug)...really any habit that the world tempts us with.
