Every day that goes by I learn something new about my Lord. I accepted him about 30 years ago, but it has taken a very long time to feel comfortable with him. My life before I accepted the Lord was nothing to brag about; I committed all the 'normal' sins that any 'normal' young man is likely to commit. As a result, I managed to store up a lot of sin memories in my psyche. Once I accepted the Lord, I knew I was forgiven of my sins but that doesn't mean they are easily forgotten. As a matter of fact, I never really felt 'adequate' as a Christian because whenever I had a memory of some of those sins, I would have a deep-rooted feeling of guilt about the memory. These guilt feelings made me feel a need to remain at arm's length from the Lord. I still love him and know he loves me unconditionally, but the guilt feelings made me feel like I didn't belong.

Over the past month or so, I've had an awakening, a renewal of my mind in fact! As I've increased my study of scripture, been involved in a discipleship study with some brothers in the church, been involved with the Freedom in Christ ministry, and reading some additional Christian literature, I have discovered a new freedom in my Lord Jesus Christ. I think all this time I've been trying to figure out what I need to do to be free of these past guilt feelings. Then I had an epiphany! There is nothing that I CAN do and nothing that I NEED to do to be free. Jesus Christ set me free of these guilt feelings when he died for me! At that moment God justified me; in other words, he cleared my slate of all sins past, there is nothing to be guilty of!

Romans 12:2 tells us "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect". I think Satan still had a hiding spot in my mind and was using his deceptive expertise to remind me that I'm inadequate and that made me want to hide from the Lord (not unlike Adam and Eve wanted to hide from God after the fall). I've come to realize that, YES, I AM inadequate, but that doesn't matter because, by God's grace, the gift that he has given me doesn't depend on me at all; it's HIS GIFT!!

As I have increased the time I spend with the Lord and learn more about HIS will, the more I learn that the Holy Spirit is with me all the time and the more I yield to His WILL, the more the spirit pushes Satan away from me.

The sense of peace, joy, and love that I've gained since this epiphany has truly changed my life! My attitude toward myself and my life has changed and the sense of freedom I feel is like a new lease on life!
