On Mondays at the Church there's a group that meets called F3. It stands for "forward for freedom". A group designed to help you confront worldly problems and give you freedom in Christ by allowing encouragement through rough times in life. On Monday, March 25, I attended a meeting.

These meetings start with a large group, where we sang songs and read statements, followed by a focused lesson by one of the senior leaders, followed by a more private and confidential group setting. In the public lesson that was done by Jackie, he spoke about the natural self as opposed to the spiritual self. Soon after, he spoke of anger, on the slides he created it mentioned "don't let the sun, go down on your anger."

I got to thinking, everything is about choice. The Lord gives you free will, the free will to have choice and whether to choose to follow him or not. Life is a series of choices. Choosing how you feel, what you do and reaction to things. Often, anger is really punishing yourself over negative stimuli. Whether getting mad because your favorite sports team lost, or mad at someone else because they wronged you. It's a choice you made to punish yourself for something outside of your control. The world punishes us enough, why do it to ourselves!?

I have recently been dating a new girl that I met while working at a temporary site while the courthouse I work at was being renovated over the winter. Things were going exceedingly well. Working together well as a team, enjoying each other's company, having foundation in Christ together, a lot of what we felt was important in life, we discussed and realized we're on the same page.

Unfortunately, recently we had a talk and she broke it off. I couldn't wrap my head around it given her reasons. She stood firm in how she enjoyed our time, she loved how I treated her and how well we were, and she loved me but decided to break it off. I went home later that evening, and felt an overwhelming sense of calmness. Why? The realization that being sad/angry is only a punishment to myself over something that somebody else has decided to do. The way I chose to respond to this situation is to keep an amicable connection and realize that you can do everything right and sometimes in life things don't happen your way.

Paul said imitate him just as he imitates Christ. In scripture, when negativity affected Christ he remained calm and chose to talk it out, using words and thoughts instead of anger or grief.

Remember you're always in control and how you respond dictates who you are. The Devil wants you angry, lashing out. Christ wants you to remain calm and give it to him.
