
Keeping Malt's Family in our prayers as they are dealing with heartbreak of the loss of their 18 year old daughter, Amy.



Seven Ways to Abide in Christ

1. **Pray** – God is never far away from us. If we have the desire place our minds within the nature and person of Jesus, God will help us do that. When we open our hearts in prayer and make ourselves vulnerable to him, he will rest with us. God will keep us in his presence if we seek him. Prayer takes work to begin, but once engaged, God helps us remain with him and causes us to abide in Christ. (Isaiah 26:3)

2. **Read the Bible** – Reading a normal book does not connect you directly to the author, but the Bible is no ordinary book. When we read the Bible, we are led into the presence of God who inspired the book. We can keep company with Jesus by simply reading the Scriptures. (Psalm 119:105)

3. Study the Bible – Reading and studying are not the same behavior. When you study, you pay closer attention to the details of what you see in the Scriptures. It means paying attention to specific words or phrases that are complex and trying to figure them out. Sometimes, you'll get out a pen or pencil and write down your observations. Studying is what we do as we try to learn. Because it is the Bible we are learning from, we are actually being taught by Christ, and he rests with the mind that engages itself to learn from him. (John 6:45)

4. Meditate – There are two ways of meditating: the mindfilling way and the mind-emptying way. When we fill our minds, it's typically with a phrase from the Scriptures. Meditation this way runs this phrase over and over again in our hearts, allowing it to settle into us. When we empty our minds, we are trying to become still within. Meditation this way attempts to quiet the interior monologue and be open in heart toward God. In both wavs, the goal is to be with God and keep company with Jesus. (Psalm 1:2)

5. **Sing** – When we combine words with music, a few things happen. One is that it can settle the ideas deep into our minds. How many lyrics to hymns do you have that you've memorized without trying? The other is that our hearts are deeply stirred and opened up for us, and nothing does this to us the way that singing can. It's a beautiful thought that when we sing with our spirits, Jesus is singing with us and over us. (Zephaniah 3:17)

6. Private Worship – Worship doesn't require an assembly of other people; you can do it alone, and should be doing it every day. The first five things in this list can all be used in a time a private worship. Worship is intentionally paying attention to God and adoring him with your heart, offering yourself to him as a living sacrifice. (Romans 12:1)

7. Corporate Worship – Worshipping God with your brothers and sisters in Christ isn't something that just happens because you arrive in the building. To do it, you need to open your heart while gathered in a worshipping congregation, becoming vulnerable to God and his word. Because worship is a form of love and adoration, a critical or angry spirit is generally antithetical to worship. Jesus promised that the one who seeks him will find him. (Matthew 7:8)

Remember that God is not far from any of us, because in Him we live and move and have our being.
